

# Ribbon Snuggler

Used in the Emergency Room and on Pediatrics.

## Materials needed:

Fleece or other soft fabric

Non-fraying ribbons in assorted colors and textures

1. Cut two (2) pieces of fabric into a 10-inch square with rounded corners.
2. Cut eight (8) pieces of assorted ribbon to 4-inch lengths.
3. Fold ribbon pieces in half with right side out to produce a loop. Stitch ribbon pieces to the right side of one of the squares with ribbon fold toward the center of the fabric and raw edges of the ribbon and fabric together.
4. Put the second fabric square on top of the ribbon square with right sides of fabric together. Stitch together, leaving an opening to turn it right side out.
5. Turn snuggler right side out. The ribbon loops will stick out like a sun with rays going out.
6. Top stitch all the way around, tucking in the seam allowance on the opening.
