We recently sent out a letter to all volunteers to validate the hours that we have recorded for the beginning months of 2025. This letter was in no way meant to reprimand anyone for any reason. We wanted to make you aware of the hours you have recorded so any discripencies could be corrected. We felt this was needed since we were seeing an increase in volunteers forgetting to record their hours.

Here are the main reminders:

- 1. Report all absences for volunteer shifts to the volunteer office.
- 2. Please make every effort to Sign in and out for all volunteer activities through Volgisitics. (This includes volunteer work that you may be doing at home, meetings, volunteer events, etc.)
- 3. If youdo forget to sign in and out for your volunteer hours, PLEASE call or text the office. We want to put these hours in so that these hours are captured. However, it is always preferable to record the hours when you ar serving. (Hopefully, recording hours after the fact, is more the exception than the rule.)
- 4. Even if recording your hours doesn't matter to you, **the hours do matter to Volunteer Services and the hospital**. Your hours help to validate the need for volunteers in the hospital.

The other reason we are encouraging you to log in while you are here is so that we know who is present in our buildings at any given time. When you log in to Volgistics, we are able to see who is present in each hospital. It is an expectation that we are able to report who is here in case of emergency. If you aren't signed in to Volgistics, we don't have an accurate list.

We hope this helps clarify why we are trying to improve our utilization of volgistics and reporting hours accurately. Thanks for your help in these efforts. We appreciate you so much!
